Join Tom Gehling for a look for what lives in and around the Hillside Natural Area. We'll head up the hillside by Moeser Lane where PG&E keeps its electricity, visit a new city park and then head down into the Hillside Nature Area to see what we can see. It is likely to be wet and muddy, and heavy rain will cancel, but there should be things to see, especially if you don't mind flipping over the occasional rock or log. The Moeser hillside will be the location for several work parties later in the year involving PG&E, El Cerrito Green Teams, and other committed volunteers working to protect and encourage native plants and habitats.

Meet at the corner of Schmidt and Navellier at 2 PM. The hike should last 2 to 2.5 hours.
